<ul style="list-style-type: none">Continue to practise your times tables on TT Rockstars and Hit the Button. Then can you time yourself completing a times tables grid like we do in class. How long does it take you? I will attach the document to our Class Dojo story but you could always create your own in your book. For an extra challenge, try changing the order of the numbers along the top row.Before we finished, we looked at the different types of triangles. Can you make a fact sheet to explain the different types of triangles? Think about their sides, what do the angles in a triangle equal and are they always the same in every triangle? You could write a book review or draw a new front cover for your book. If you are running out of books, you could ask somebody to sign you up to Lancashire Libraries to download free ebooks to read or listen to free audiobooks.Those of you who have been given a Reading Plus account, try to log on and complete at least 5 reading lessons and 1 vocabulary lesson per week.Any of you who were given a Nessy account, try to log on and continue practising your spellings.Keep your diary going – I've loved reading them on your Class Dojo pages and it's great to document what you've been up to.

Learning Project – Ancient Greece (Who were the Ancient Greeks?)

This week, I would like you to do some research into the Ancient Greeks. Can you find out the answers to some of these questions?

- Where is Greece? Do you know the continent it is in? Which countries are nearby? Which seas or oceans surround Greece?
- What is the capital city of Greece today?
- When were the Ancient Greeks around?
- What are the Ancient Greeks famous for?
- Could you do some extra research into Ancient Greek myths to link with this week's Literacy work?
- Maybe you could go on a tour of some famous Greek sites using Google Earth and street view? Athens is filled with Ancient Greek culture so could be a good place to explore.

You *could* make some notes or perhaps even make a poster to share what you found out.

You *could* find/draw a map of Greece and label it.

You *could* make an information video about what you have researched.

Weekly Challenge – Art (Mrs Simpkins)

This week I am setting you an art challenge. I want you to make a portrait of someone in your family. A portrait is a picture of someone usually showing their head, neck and shoulders.
