Weekly Maths Tasks

- Follow Week 1 of [White Rose Maths](#). There is a lesson for every day.
Check your Class Dojo for some extra instructions.
**Year 6 Maths is all about consolidating the whole range of maths skills from across KS2. You may wish to use Year 5 lessons to revise past skills, rather than the Year 6 lessons.*

- Make sure you continue to consolidate all times table facts (up to 12x12). Keep using [TT Rockstars](#) or [Hit the Button](#) Focus on tables that you find tricky or use to consolidate all times tables.
- Make sure you can tell the time to the nearest minute. This is a valuable life skill and one you will need when you are following a high school timetable. [BBC Bitesize](#) have some great resources you could look at.

- Follow Week 1 of [Literacy Y6 Plan](#)
