### Learning Project – Under and Over the Ocean

I hope you had fun with some of your topic work last week. I would like you to continue with some activities linked to our topic

- Last term we read 'Aliens Love Underpants'. This week I want you to listen to the story '[Pirates Love Underpants](#)'
- Pirates use maps to hide then find their treasure. I'd like you to draw your own treasure map and see if your mum or dad can guess where you have hidden the treasure. Look at our Class Dojo for an example. Like the map on this sheet: You can draw your own, ask for help with the co-ordinates. Tell me where my treasure is, using your Dojos.
- Do some research to name the main oceans of the world. How many can you name?
- Have some fun doing a treasure hunt in your garden.

Try to use directions such as: Take 6 steps forward then a half turn right. Take 5 more steps and turn a quarter turn left. This [BBC bitesize clip](#) may help.

### Weekly Challenge – Geography (Mr Gilyead)

This week I would like you to look at maps, atlases, a globe or of course...Google Earth! Can you find the 4 countries of the UK, their capital cities and the seas that surround them? If you are using Google Earth you could go onto street view and have a look around. The whole world is split into 7 parts called continents. Can you find these continents and the 5 oceans as well? You could learn this [great catchy song](#) to help you! Remember to upload your work to Class Dojo. You could write, draw or make videos. Maybe you could video yourself singing that Geography Song – if your parents aren't fed up of hearing it yet!!
