Weekly Maths Tasks

- Follow Summer Term – Week 2 (w/c 27th April) of [White Rose](#) maths. Don't worry about the dates not matching up. There is a lesson for every day.

Weekly English Tasks

- Follow Week 4 of Lancashire English Plans. There is a lesson for every day. *Check your Class Dojo for some extra instructions each day.*

- Still on time this week- continue to try and read the time at home. Can you use an analogue and digital clock? To challenge yourself, try this [game](#) and have a go at answering the problems about adding on time. The best thing for telling the time is to keep practising!
- Continue your times tables practice at home using Hit the button, TTRockstars and Daily 10 arithmetic. You could get an adult to give you a times tables test at home.

Reading:

- Follow the rest of our class novel "Holes" on Class Dojo.
- Continue with your reading at home – it's so important. Any book is great! Try to read a chapter as often as you can. Tell your adult how you would like the story to end.
- Those of you on Reading Plus should aim to log on and complete 5 x 30 minute sessions a week. You can do this independently and don't need an adult's help.

Spelling:

- Have a look at [spelling rule 47](#) on [spellingframe.com](#) about words with silent letters. the spelling tiles and practice/test. Can you learn some/all words from the list and do your own spelling test at home?

Learning Project – Ancient Greece (Art)
