Weekly Maths Tasks

- Follow Summer Term [Week5](#) of White Rose maths -wb18520. (We are working behind their schedule)
The theme this week is **fractions**. After offering free resources for the first few weeks of lockdown, the site has reverted to being subscription only. The videos will still be in the usual place but because we are a subscribing school, you will find the worksheets on our [website](#).
There will be posts on the Year 4 [Class Dojo](#) page if any further extra instructions are needed.
- *There will also be similar activities posted on [BBC bitesize daily](#). There is no need to do both*
- This week try 5 more from Topmark's [Daily Ten](#). Choose level 3 or 4 then select a different challenge each day:
Monday – Rounding
Tuesday – Multiplication
Wednesday – Division
Thursday – Doubles / Halves
Friday – Fractions
Choose any one of the challenges that appear each day and decide how many seconds you want between each question.

Weekly English Tasks

- Follow Week 5 of the Lancashire English Plans for [Year4](#). There is a lesson for every day. This week the reading and writing theme is **Fantastic Beasts** and has a mainly nonfiction focus.
Check the year 4 [Class Dojo](#) for any extra instructions, files and resources that might be useful during the week.
- In this week's spellings, the words are all homophones. Each pair sounds the same when you read them but they are spelt differently and have a different meaning.
There are many homophones in our language. Some appeared in the autumn and spring lists. Here are another eight to try:
wood / would, flour / flower, night / knight, mist / missed
Have someone test you next Friday (or whenever you are ready) and post a photo or text message to your portfolio.

- Learn the next times table towards your tables certificate or keep practising to keep your skills fresh. You could write them on paper or a whiteboard like we do at school. Maybe get somebody in your house to test you. There are lots of options.
