Weekly Maths Tasks

- Follow Summer Term Week 6 (w/c 1st June) of [White Rose Maths](#). You may need to scroll down to find this. There are lessons and activities for each day. The worksheets are available from the school website and our class dojo page. If you can't print out the worksheets just write the answers in your **red maths book**.
- If you are in Year 2 start with the Year 1 lesson, then move onto the Year 2 lesson if you are ready for a challenge.

Weekly English Tasks

- Follow Week 6 of [Lancs English Plans](#) on Under the Sea. There is a lesson for every day. This work is appropriate for Year 1s and Year 2s in our class. When you do any writing remember to use a **red pencil or pen** to underline capital letters and tick full stops.
- This week **Blue Sticker spellings** are; **day, very, Mrs, by, made**.
Green sticker spellings are; **bear, can't, again, cat, long**.
Please write these on the next page in your spelling book. Test yourself at the end of the week.

- Year 1s. Can you remember the pairs of numbers that total 10 e.g. $9 + 1 = 10$? Can you write them in order? Try playing this [darts game](#) to help you remember them (espresso log in details are the same as for Ash's Phonics). Now can you work out the pairs of numbers that total 100 e.g. $90 + 10 = 100$? How many different ways can you find?
- Year 2s continue learning 2, 5 and 10 times tables. These [songs](#) might help you to learn and practise them.
You could still use the [Coconut Multiples game](#) to help you practise as well.

- Follow our class novel The BFG on Class Dojo. I will post a new chapter each day.
- Read a book yourself each day if you can. This could be one of your own books from home or an online book from [Collins Big Cat](#). You will need to sign in as a teacher with these details
