COVID Query

We often get questions linked to COVID and find ourselves going back through the Government guidance or ringing our local authority for clarification - it is a complicated at times so we understand why it is not always straight forward to interpret!

One question this week is likely to crop up and so felt worth sharing with the wider community: If a pupil has tested positive within 90 days **but** starts to show new symptoms, what should you do?

The answer we received is that nobody should take a PCR test within 90 days of a positive result **unless they start to show new symptoms**. In this case, a test should be booked as the theory is it could be a new variant which must be tested and checked for.

COVID Contingency Plan

We are in a position to put our plan in place with our Year 5 class, hopefully for a short period. In summary, many of the 'bubble' arrangements are in place until the middle of next week.

No pupils are asked to isolate and should continue to attend school under the new Government measures. However, it seems sensible to highlight these changes to the school

community so that they are informed. We are aware that this is likely to happen on a fairly regular basis during the school year.
