Online Safety

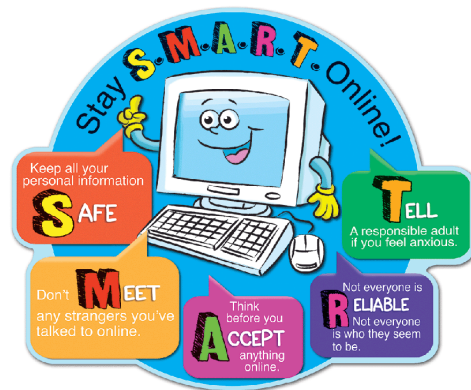
