#### Strikes

There is further industrial action from teaching members of NEU on Tuesday 28th February. As you are aware, members are not required to inform their employer of their intention to strike in advance but, should they do so, I will inform parents immediately of any class closures (including over the weekend if required so as to give as much notice as possible).

It is really important that **all families make a contingency plan** for strike days, as has been previously mentioned, whether their child's class has been previously affected or not. I am sure you will be aware that many local schools have been required to close some classes during these strikes.

The remaining dates are Tuesday 28th February, Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March. This is obviously a highly unusual period and disruptive for all but any teachers, whether here or at other schools, will have thought long and hard before taking the decision to strike.

## **UK Voting Changes**

With a general election due in the next eighteen months, a bit of public service broadcasting about voting changes that may have gone under the radar:

From 4 May 2023, voters in England will need to show photo ID to vote at polling stations in some elections. This will apply to: Local elections, Police and Crime Commissioner elections, UK parliamentary by-elections, Recall petitions. From October 2023, it will also apply to UK General elections.

If you don't have accepted photo ID, you can apply for a free voter ID document, which is known as a Voter Authority Certificate.
