## Swimming

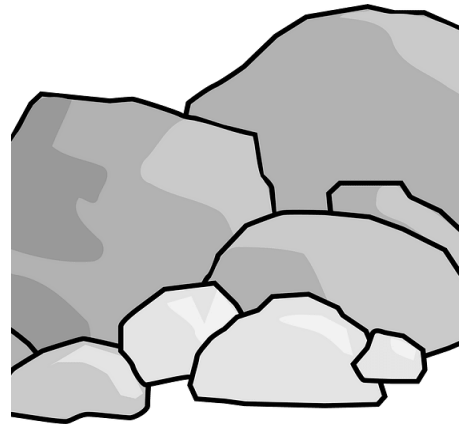
There will be swimming for both Year 3 and Year 4 again next week.
