Collection of pupils from Infant playground

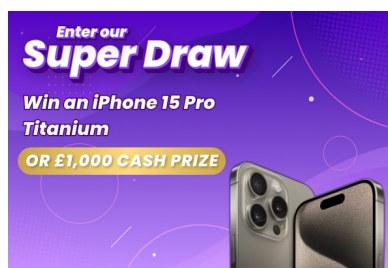
