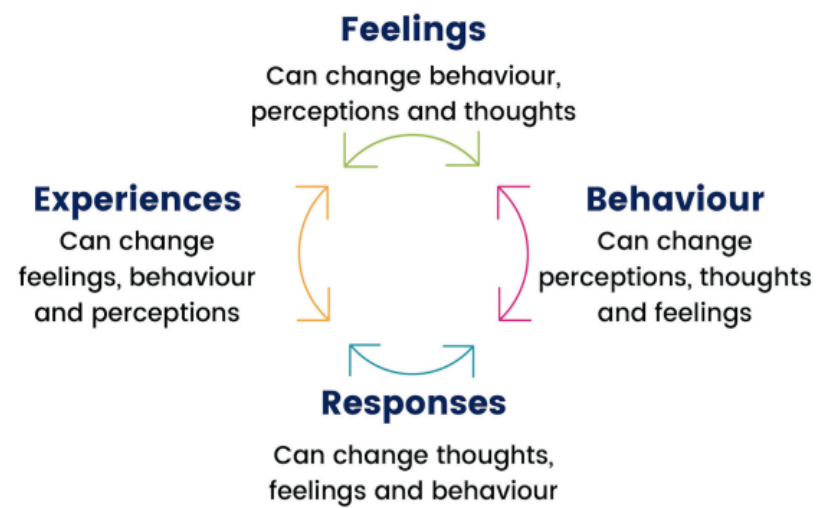


Why?

Silver Leaves

The Moss Side Way was created long ago, shaped from the moment school opened in 1982 - to keep that in mind, every member of our school community (including parents and visitors) may nominate someone who has followed **The Moss Side Way**. Each week, chosen nominees place a 'silver leaf' on our school tree.

- Time to reflect on our choices
- Completing 'Think Sheets' (from Year 2)
- Verbal discussions
- **Choices have consequences** - sometimes a poor choice can lead to a consequence such as:
 - Verbal reminder
 - Missing break time
 - Loss of a responsibility
 - Letter of apology
- Every time a consequence is given, **restoration** forms part of the process - a chance to reflect how we can better follow **The Moss Side Way**
 - What could I do differently next time?
 - Who can help me?
 - Do I need to apologise to someone?
